
HOW TO PROGRAMME A FORZA (BFOR12) OPENER





- Limit Setting starting with the door in the closed position, press the "P" button^① for 5 seconds. The unit will beep once and "1" will be displayed on the screen[®]. Press the "P" button^① again and "1" will flash on the screen[®]. Press and hold the "+" button[®] and the door will move in the up direction. Release the "+" button[®] once the door has reached the desired open position. The open position may be fine tuned by pressing the "-" button[®]. Once happy with your open position press the "P" button[®] once to save your setting
- To set the close limit, press the "+" button[®] once again and "2" will be displayed on the screen[®]. Press the "P" button[®] again and "2" will flash on the screen[®]. Press and hold the "-" button[®] and the door will move in the down direction. Release the "-" button[®] once the door has reached the desired closed position. The closed position may be fined tuned by pressing the "+" button[®]. Once happy with your closed position, wait 2 seconds and press the "P" button[®] to save the settings.
- The force now needs to be set. Press the "+" button[®] once again and "3" will be displayed on the screen[®]. Press the "P" button[®] again and "3" flashes on the screen[®]. The door will open automatically. Press "P" button[®] when the door stops and then press "P" button[®] again and the door will close automatically. Once the door stops, press "P" button[®] continuously for 5 seconds to save your settings and exit programming.
- To program the remote to this unit, press the "S" button[®] until "O" appears on the screen[®] and then release the "S" button[®]. Press the desired button[®] on your remote that you wish to use. The "O" on the screen[®] will disappear and your remote has been coded.
